Edgar Dewdney was married here in 1864, after building his famous gold rush trail



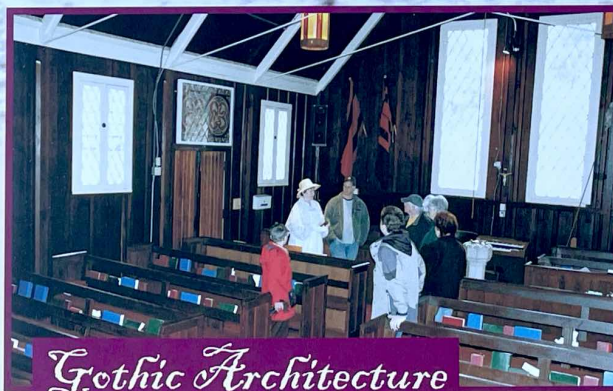
Susan Allison married at Christ Church in 1868. She became a celebrated rancher and mother of 14 children

Christ Church, summer 1924



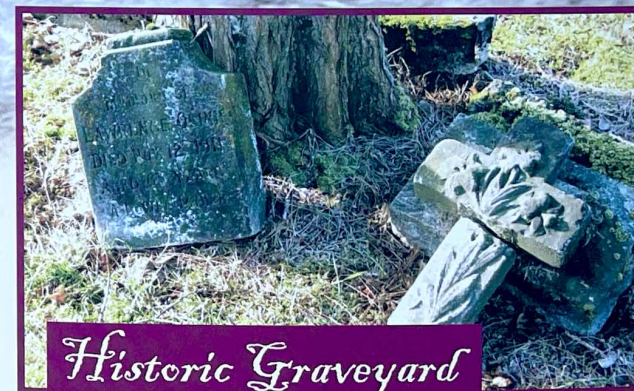
Public Tours

Gothic Architecture

Christ Church is a stunning example of an Anglican parish church in the Gothic Revival style. Its leaded glass windows were brought by steamship from England around the southern tip of South America.



Historic Graveyard

The Old Hope Cemetery (formerly Anglican) can be explored, a short walk from Christ Church. You'll be captivated by the people and stories of frontier life in this wilderness outpost that was Fort Hope.
